

## **3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Supply List**

**Student Personal Supplies** (Labeled with their name, and to be sent on the first day of school):

- **Two** stitch-bound, wide-ruled “composition notebooks” for writing and math, which often have a marbled looking cover, **not** spiral bound, and **not** perforated tear-out pages. Ideally two different colored covers would be great!
- Five paper folders with inner pockets: one folder for reading, one for social studies, one for writing, one for math and one to hold artwork
- 1 Sketchpad (optional) - for students who enjoy drawing to keep artwork organized and which saves on classroom paper.
- Water bottle that is labeled

Please **NO** personal pencil sharpeners, pencil-end erasers, scissors, or pencil boxes are needed, as all the students have desks with upper and lower cubbies.

### **Classroom donations:**

- Two 12-Pack boxes of **No. 2 Ticonderoga “Tri-Write”** three-sided or like pencils per family available at OfficeMax, Fred Meyer, or online. The purpose of these specific pencils is to help children develop a better pencil grip. Also, we burn through them very quickly.
- 1 tissue box
- 1 glue stick
- One 2pk of standard pink erasers
