Student Personal Supplies

Please *label these items* with your child's name before sending them to school. These supplies should be purchased before school starts. Students will be using some of these things right away.

- 3-ring binder (1 ½” or 2”—not too big, please avoid those that zip-close)
- One package of 5 dividers
- 4 stitch-bound, wide ruled “composition notebooks” (*not* spiral bound, *not* perforated tear-out pages)
- 5 different colored folders with pockets
- Water bottle with a secure lid –(Please avoid those that have a “mist” feature.)
- Sketchpad – **optional**, for students who enjoy drawing so they can keep artwork organized
- An inexpensive USB Flash Drive
- A book at your just-right reading level. (Or choose one on the first day of school.)

Community Supplies

Please have each student bring in the following supplies *to share* with the community. In order to reduce divisive climate that occurs when supplies are shared with some students but not all, these supplies will be community supplies and *should not be labeled with student names*.

- Two packages of pencils (I prefer Ticonderoga)
- 4 erasers (white plastic or vinyl erasers are best)
- 1 Box of Tissues
- 1-2 rolls standard size masking tape and 1-2 rolls invisible tape
