

Middle School Supply List

At Salmon Bay, we do not allow backpacks in the classrooms. Students transport supplies between classes in either an accordion folder or 3 ring binder. We encourage families to consider this a 1st Semester supply list. It is often necessary to resupply certain items before the start of the 2nd Semester.

Organizational Supplies

1 accordion folder

OR

3 ring binder with 6 subject pocket dividers

USB flash drive (labeled with name)

OR

MS Office 365

Daily planner (Optional for students who do not want to use the one provide by the school)

6 composition books with lined paper (college rule recommended)

15 Post-it note pads (3 x 3)

1 set of Post-it flags associated (.5 x 2inch) (for 7th and 8th grade only)

1 inch White 3 ring view binder (8.5 x 11 inch) (for 7th and 8th grade only)

Writing Supplies

One set to keep, one to donate to communal supply:

2 24 packs of No. 2 pencils - Ticonderoga Brand recommended!

2 erasers

2 pack of blue or black pens

2 pack of highlighters in at least three colors

2 packs of 100 sheets of lined notebook paper (college rule)

1 college - ruled composition book (for communal supply)

Pencil pouch (for personal use)

Math Supplies

¼ inch graph paper packet (80 sheets)

12" Ruler with metric and standard measurements

Calculator (scientific for 7th and 8th grade, regular for 6th grade)

For 6th grade math: 1 Spiral Bound Quad Ruled notebook

For 7th grade math: 1 spiral bound notebook

For 8th grade math: 1 Quad ruled composition book

For Geometry Students: **Spiral bound Quad-ruled notebook, Compass, Protractor and 2 differently colored highlighters**

Special Project Supplies

12 glue sticks

Colored pencils

Box of ultra

fine point black sharpies

3x5 lined index cards (pack of 100)

Pair of scissors
